HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 121 of 1942.

CONTROL OF BUILDING MATERIALS.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the acquisition and disposal of building materials in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland (each of which is hereinafter respectively referred to as "the Territory").

REGULATIONS.

1. In this Notice—

"prohibited stock" shall mean that percentage of the total quantity of the goods enumerated in Schedules B and E hereof, which are in the possession or control of any merchant in the Territory at the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, or which are acquired after the said date, as is specified in the last column of the said Schedules;

"unprohibited stock" shall mean that portion of the total quantity of the said goods in the possession or control of any merchant which does not constitute prohibited stock;

"merchant" shall mean any company, firm or person dealing within the Territory in the purchase, sale or supply of any goods specified in Schedules B and E hereof, or any amendment thereof, but shall not include any manufacturer, wholesaler or contractor as defined hereafter;

"wholesaler" shall mean any company, firm or person dealing within the Territory in the purchase, sale or supply exclusively to merchants of any of the goods specified in Schedules B and E hereof, or any amendment thereof. Any wholesaler who sells or disposes of any portion of such goods to persons other than merchants or wholesalers shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of that portion of such goods offered for sale or disposal to persons other than merchants;

"manufacturer" shall mean any company, firm or person whose place of business is within the Territory and who is engaged in the manufacture and the sale or supply exclusively to merchants ~~or wholesalers~~ of any of the goods specified in Schedules B and E hereof, or any amendment thereof. Any manufacturer who sells or disposes of any portion of such goods to persons other than merchants ~~or wholesalers~~ shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of that portion of such goods offered for sale or disposal to such persons;

"contractor" shall mean any company, firm or person carrying on within the Territory the regular business of undertaking the performance of work entailing the use by such company, firm or person of any of the goods specified in Schedules B and E hereof, or any amendment thereof, and shall include any institution, company, firm or person undertaking the construction or maintenance and repair of any buildings or structures in its possession. Any contractor who sells or disposes of such goods otherwise than in the execution of works being carried out by such contractor shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of that portion of goods offered for sale or disposal. Any merchant, ~~wholesaler~~ or manufacturer who carries on the regular business of undertaking the performance of work entailing the use by such merchant, ~~wholesaler~~ or manufacturer of any of such goods shall be considered as a contractor in respect of that portion of his business so conducted;

"goods" shall mean any unused building material, article, equipment or fitting specified in Schedules B and E hereof;

"defence work" shall mean any work or service being carried out by any Naval, Military or Air Force or by any Government Department, Agent or Contractor on behalf of such Force;

"authorised officer" shall mean [for the purposes of paragraph (1) of regulation 5] an officer or official under whose direction and control

the defence works are being executed and who is empowered to sign such certificate by any Naval, Military or Air Force or by any Government Department on behalf of such Force;

“ Controller ” shall mean the Government Secretary or such other officer as he may appoint.

2. Any merchant to whom the provisions of these regulations apply shall separate that portion of the stock which constitutes prohibited stock from that portion which constitutes unprohibited stock.

3. Every merchant shall, in respect of each item of the goods specified in the Schedules and in respect of both the prohibited and unprohibited stock, keep the following records:—

- (i) The quantities in stock or under his control at the date of the publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*;
- (ii) the quantities acquired after the said date and the dates of such acquisition; and
- (iii) the quantities disposed of by sale or otherwise after the said date in each calendar month.

4. Every merchant shall, in respect of the specified goods in his possession or control, make a monthly return, in duplicate, in the form B. 1 attached hereto:

Provided that where the stocks-in hand of any one of the items—

- (i) enumerated in Schedule B amount to less than £10 (ten pounds) in retail value; or
- (ii) enumerated in Schedule E amount to less than £5 (five pounds) in retail value;

no return need be made in respect of such item.

Returns shall reflect the true position as at the last day of the month and shall be duly certified in the manner prescribed in form B. 1.

Returns must be made in respect of every calendar month commencing with the month of June, 1942, provided that, in the case of the return for the month of June, 1942, the only information required is the detail of stocks on hand.

Returns must reach the Controller on or before the fifteenth day of the month following that in respect of which the return is made.

The actual quantities of stocks on hand representing the prescribed percentage shall be stated in the columns headed “ Prohibited Stock ” and “ Unprohibited Stock ” respectively in form B. 1. Such quantities shall be stated in terms of the units of measurement prescribed in Schedules B and E.

Stocks on hand shall include the quantities on hand in bond and in storage, also all stocks in transit, but not stocks at any branch office. Merchants holding or

controlling stocks at more than one point shall make separate returns in respect of each point.

The item number of each description of goods held must be indicated in the monthly return and must coincide with the number shown for those goods in the Schedules B and E.

Where there is more than one size or type mentioned against any item, these may be grouped together for the purposes of these regulations.

Copies of form B. 1 may be obtained from the Controller.

5. No merchant who deals in any goods specified in the Schedule shall, as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, dispose of any prohibited stock except:—

- (1) In fulfilment of a written order endorsed with a certificate by an authorised officer in the following form:—

I certify that the goods specified in this order are required for *Defence Works*.

Each order shall be submitted in duplicate by a contractor, agent or official to the Officer-in-Charge of the Defence Works who shall retain one copy of each certified order for the purpose of record and checking the delivery and destination of the goods enumerated in the order.

No merchant shall refuse to supply the goods specified in the certified order if he has such goods in stock.

- (2) On the authority of and subject to the conditions of a permit issued by the Controller or by an Officer duly authorised by him to act on his behalf.

An application for a permit must be made in writing by the person desiring to acquire the goods and the application must be endorsed by the merchant holding the prohibited stock.

An applicant for a permit must furnish the following information:—

- (i) Full details of the location and nature of the works for which the goods are required.
- (ii) A full list of the goods required in the order of, and quoting the item numbers as set forth in, Schedules B and E hereto;
- (iii) The name of the merchant who will supply the goods to be supplied.

The applicant shall further satisfy the Controller that all reasonable steps have been taken to obtain the goods required from unprohibited stocks within the Territory.

Any permit to acquire prohibited stock shall be surrendered to the merchant who shall retain same for record.

No permit bearing any erasure or alteration shall be accepted by a merchant.

NOTE.—No applications for permits for the acquisition of prohibited stocks will be considered except for urgent and essential requirements for Government and public services.

6. Any merchant to whom the provisions of these regulations apply may make written application to the Controller for the disposal from prohibited stocks of any goods specified in the Schedules which are not of the quality or standard required for defence works or services.

Such application shall contain a full and complete description of such goods to enable an inspection to be made of such goods by an inspector duly delegated for that purpose by the Controller.

If so required, the merchant shall deposit with the Controller a sample of the goods in question.

No merchant shall dispose of any such goods from prohibited stocks except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions of a permit issued by the Controller or by an Officer duly authorised by him to act on his behalf.

7. Any merchant to whom the provisions of these regulations apply may dispose of any unprohibited stock provided that he satisfies himself that the goods to be disposed of are required for fulfilling the purchaser's immediate and necessary requirements.

No purchaser shall acquire such goods except for such requirements.

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Notice, the Controller may, in his discretion, grant exemption from the whole or any of the provisions of this Notice to any person, or in respect of any item of the goods referred to herein.

9. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
