It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 227 of 1941, dealing with the control of Exports, by adding after item (x) in sub-paragraph (a) of the first paragraph the following new items:—

- (xii) Hides
- (xiii) Toluol.
- (xiv) Acetone.
- (xv) Butyl alcohol.
- (xvi) Amyl alcohol.
- (xvii) Butyl acetate.
- (xviii) Amyl acetate.
- (xix) Ethyl acetate.
- (xx) Oats and oat products.
- (xxi) Vegetable seeds.
- (xxii) Dried peas.
- (xxiii) Dried beans.
- (xxiv) Putty.
- (xxv) Lead.
- (xxvi) Vulcanised india-rubber electrical wire and flex.
- (xxvii) Tyres and tubes.
- (xxviii) Matches.
