CONTROL OF CORRUGATED STEEL SHEETS  
(CORRUGATED IRON).

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the sub-joined regulations relating to the control of corrugated steel sheets (corrugated iron) in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate, and Swaziland.

REGULATIONS.

1. In these regulations unless inconsistent with the content:-

"Controller" means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint;

"corrugated sheets" means any unused corrugated sheets made of iron or steel, whether galvanised or ungalvanised.

2. No person shall, as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, acquire any corrugated sheets or use them, as aforesaid, of and subject to the grade or a permit issued by the Controller.

3. No application for a permit will be considered unless the applicant completes the form of declaration embodied in Schedule - Form C S 1 hereto, copies of which may now be obtained from the Controller.

4. To obtain a permit as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, sell, supply or dispose of any corrugated sheets to any other person except upon delivery to one of a person listed in terms of section 14 hereof, such person or selling, supplier or transporter or carrier or other must complete the endorsement at the foot of the permit and forward the permit to the Controller.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Controller may in his discretion grant exemption from the whole or any of the provisions of these regulations.

6. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations, or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
