HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 161 of 1942.

It is hereby notified for general information that, notwithstanding the provisions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Labour Proclamation, 1941 (No. 56 of 1941), His Excellency the High Commissioner has, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), as amended, been pleased to prohibit the recruitment of labour in the Bechuanaland Protectorate by any person from the 10th July, 1942, until further notice except with the written authority of and subject to any conditions which may be imposed by the Resident Commissioner.
