HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

CONTROL OF PARAFFIN WAX.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the rendering of returns of paraffin wax in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland.

REGULATIONS.

1. Every company, firm or person owning or having power to dispose of or being in possession or control of any paraffin wax shall render a return of stocks of such paraffin wax held at the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, in the manner prescribed in the form attached hereto:

Provided that where the total stocks of paraffin wax held amount to less than one short ton (2,000 lb.) no return need be made.

2. Stocks must be expressed in short tons and the respective melting points must be indicated.

3. Returns must reach the Government Secretary within fourteen days after the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*.

No forms will be supplied.

4. Any person who fails to comply with any provision of these regulations or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
