Letters: 1½d. per ½ oz.

Post cards: 1½d. each.

Newspapers: ½d. per 4 oz. per copy. Limit of weight for each packet, 1 lb.

Printed papers: ½d. per 2 oz.

Commercial papers: ½d. per 2 oz.

Sample packets: ½d. per 2 oz., minimum 1d.

Parcels: 1s. 11d. per lb. (Ghanzi 2s. 5d. per lb.

Kasane 1s. 8d. per lb.)
