HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 234 of 1942.

CONTROL OF PAPER.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 109 of 1942 as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 211 of 1942 as follows:—

1. By the deletion of paragraph (c) of section 2 and the substitution therefor of the following paragraphs:—

“(c) (a) to print any repeat of any printed document, book, otherwise than provided for in paragraphs (c) (b) and (c) (e) of this sub-regulation, or form, including any such document, book or form of which the dimensions are prescribed by law, except in a size which represents at least fifty per cent. reduction in the dimensions of such document, book or form, provided that in the case of a further reprint a second reduction shall not be compulsory unless it can be conveniently made (Statutory Customs forms are exempted from this provision);

(c) (b) for the printing or reprinting of any educational books which have been recommended or prescribed for an Educational Institution, unless the printer or publisher has received permission therefor from the Controller and unless he can satisfy the Controller that by such printing or reprinting a general saving will be accomplished of twenty-five per cent. of the paper used for such purposes as compared with—

- (i) the year ended 31st July, 1939; or
- (ii) the year ended 31st December, 1941, in the case of firms who were not in existence for a year at 31st July, 1939; or
- (iii) any other period which the Controller at his discretion may lay down, upon application, in an exceptional case:

(c) (c) for the printing or reprinting of any books or other literature which in the opinion of the Controller cannot be classed among the foregoing paragraph (b) unless the printer or publisher has obtained permission therefor from the Controller and unless he can satisfy the Controller that by such printing or reprinting a general saving will be accomplished of fifty per cent. of the paper used for such purposes as compared with—

- (i) the year ended 31st July, 1939; or
- (ii) the year ended 31st December, 1941, in the case of firms who were not in existence for a year at 31st July, 1939; or
- (iii) any other period which the Controller at his discretion may lay down, upon application, in an exceptional case."

2. By the deletion of paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 13 and the substitution therefor of the following paragraphs:—

"(a) unless the Controller has been notified of the size, substance, colour, type of paper or board, actual net tonnage, country of origin and import permit and/or certificate of essentiality number; and

(b) until after the expiration of fourteen days from the date of receipt by the Controller of such notification."

3. By the deletion of the definition of "paper" in section 17 and the substitution therefor of the following definition:—

" ' paper ' means all types of paper, including cardboard, paperboard, strawboard and the like, both in the raw and in the manufactured or made-up form."
