HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 236 of 1942.

CONTROL OF RADIO APPARATUS AND COMPONENTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to—

- (a) repeal High Commissioner's Notice No. 163 of 1942;
- (b) prohibit the sale or supply by any person to any other person of any communication or commercial type radio receiver not specifically designed for domestic broadcast reception and similar to those manufactured by—
 - (1) The National Company Incorporated, Massachusetts;
 - (2) The Hallicrafter Company, Chicago;
 - (3) The Howard Radio Company, Chicago;
 - (4) The Hammarlund Manufacturing Company, Incorporated, New York;

with effect from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* and until further notice, except upon the authority of a permit issued by the Government Secretary or by an officer duly authorised by him to act on his behalf

2. All applications for a permit as aforesaid must be addressed to the Government Secretary.

3. Any person who contravenes any prohibition hereby imposed shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment
