

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 239 of 1942.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section six of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, Union, Southern Rhodesia, and Northern Rhodesia Trade Regulation Proclamation, 1937 (No. 66 of 1937), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 199 of 1937 as follows:—

The following new regulation is hereby inserted immediately after regulation (4) of the said regulations:—

" (5) The provisions of these regulations shall not apply to the removal from the Bechuanaland Protectorate to the Union of South Africa of any motor vehicle imported from Southern Rhodesia and registered in the Bechuanaland Protectorate under any law in force for the registration of motor vehicles if the owner of any such vehicle is the holder of a current tryptique issued by any body or association approved by the Resident Commissioner:

Provided that if the owner of any such vehicle aforesaid is not the holder of a current tryptique, he shall, before removing the said vehicle to the Union of South Africa, deposit with the District Commissioner of the district in which the vehicle is registered an amount to be fixed by the District Commissioner or shall furnish security to the satisfaction of the District Commissioner for the payment of a like amount, for the satisfaction of any duty which may be payable in terms of section 1 (a) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, Union, Southern Rhodesia, and Northern Rhodesia Trade Regulation Proclamation, 1937 (No. 66 of 1937) "
