HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 257 OF 1942.

CONTROL OF RUBBER.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit and order as follows:—

1. In this Notice—

- (a) "dealer" means any person engaged in the business of retail sale or supply of pneumatic tyres, and includes persons engaged in the business of selling new or used motor vehicles or axle and wheel assemblies, and who carry stocks of pneumatic tyres for fitment to such vehicles or assemblies;
- (b) "new tyre" means an undamaged tyre casing which has not been used to the extent of more than 100 miles of travel.

2. From and after the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* no dealer to whom a permit to purchase a new tyre or tyres is presented shall, in satisfaction of such permit, supply from stocks in his possession or control any new 6-ply outer cover of a pneumatic tyre of any of the following sizes:—

6·00 × 16	7·00 × 16
6·50 × 16	7·50 × 16

3. Every dealer who at the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* has in his possession or control any used vehicle or wheel assembly (other than an unused motor vehicle) to which is fitted any new tyre or tyres of the size and ply mentioned in regulation 2 of this Notice shall remove such tyre or tyres from the said vehicle or wheel assembly: Provided, however, that such new tyres so removed may notwithstanding the provisions of High Commissioner's Notice No. 171 of 1942, be replaced by such tyres other than 6-ply tyres referred to in regulation

2 of this Notice, as the dealer may possess; and provided further that the number of tyres so replaced must be specifically referred to in the monthly returns of tyre transactions rendered by dealers to the Controller.

4. Every dealer having in his possession or control at the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* any new tyres as defined in these regulations shall render a return of such tyres to the Controller of Rubber not later than the 10th day of October, 1942, in the form set out hereunder.
