HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 278 of 1942.

CONTROL OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 168 of 1942 by inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph 11:—

"11A. A motor vehicle acquired under the authority of a permit issued in terms of this Schedule shall not be disposed of within a period of twelve months from the date of registration unless the Controller has given his consent in writing to such disposal. After the said period has elapsed, the said motor vehicle shall no longer be subject to the provision of this Schedule."
