HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 299 of 1942.
CONTROL OF PETROLATUM.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 25 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit and order as follows:—

1. As from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* no person shall use petrolatum in the manufacture of toilet preparations for the hair.

2. Regulation 2 of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 279 of 1942 is hereby amended by the addition of the following item (vii):—

“(vii) average monthly quantity (in lb.) of petrolatum used during the six months preceding date of application (give separate details of quantities used for each commodity).”

3. Regulation 4 of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 279 of 1942 is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-paragraph (c) of the said regulation.
