CONTROL OF BUILDING MATERIALS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to order that the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 121 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 159 of 1942, shall apply to the under-mentioned goods even where such goods are assembled together in complete or incomplete fittings or units:—
