REGULATIONS RELATING TO ACQUISITION
AND DISPOSAL OF MEALIES AND MEALIE
PRODUCTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 182 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 270 of 1942, by deleting from sub-paragraph (d) of the first paragraph the words "five bags per month in the case of a *bona fide* farmer or two bags per month in the case of any other person" and substituting therefor the words "two bags per month".
