HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 330 OF 1942.

CONTROL OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 138 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 278 of 1942, as follows:—

1. By the insertion in paragraph 1 of the following additional definition:—

“ Dealer ” shall mean any company, firm or person whose business or part of whose business it is to sell or supply any new motor vehicle and shall include any company, firm or person whose business or part of whose business it is to assemble new motor vehicles.

2. By the insertion, immediately after the words “ motor vehicle ” in the fifth line of paragraph 7, of the words “ and shall immediately thereafter return such permit to the Controller ”.

3. By the deletion of paragraph 10 and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—

“ 10. (a) Every dealer shall render a statement showing the number, make and types of new motor vehicles imported by him during each calendar month. In the case of trucks, the wheelbase, capacity and model of such trucks shall also be specified.

(b) Every dealer shall render a statement in the manner prescribed hereunder, of new motor vehicles sold or supplied, and delivered by him during each calendar month.”
