CONTROL OF OIL.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939, (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 135 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notices Nos. 167 of 1942 and 205 of 1942, by inserting the following new regulation immediately after regulation 9:—

“ 9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, a wholesaler or reseller may supply an official operating Government-owned motor transport with his immediate requirements of engine oil and/or other lubricant upon production of a duly signed official Government order in respect of such requirements.”
