HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 340 of 1942.**

**CONTROL OF CERTAIN TYPES OF CON-
TAINERS AND MATERIALS AND TWINE.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 145 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 258 of 1942, as follows:—

- (a) By deleting Schedules "A", "B" and "C" and substituting therefor Schedules "A", "B" and "C" as set out in the Annexure hereto; and
- (b) by deleting regulations 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and substituting therefor the following regulations:—

"1. Every person who as at the 31st December, 1942, has any jute or hessian material or containers or sewing twine on indent, but which has not yet arrived in the Territory at that date, shall on or before the 7th January, 1943, furnish a return in writing containing the following particulars:—

- (1) Name and address of importer.
- (2) Indent number and date of indent.
- (3) Description of goods.
- (4) Quantity in bales.
- (5) Packing (quantity per bale).
- (6) Period of shipment as per indent.
- (7) Port of discharge.
- (8) Name and address of shipper.
- (9) If wholly or in part for account of third parties, specify quantities and names and addresses of such third parties.
- (10) Whether for sale or consumption in the Territory or elsewhere and, if for export, the country of destination.

2. Every person who, subsequent to the 31st December, 1942, places any order for jute or hessian material or containers or sewing twine from a source outside the Territory, shall render a return as called for in Schedules 'A' and 'B' hereto, not later than the 7th day of each month in respect of the immediately preceding month, and shall furnish advice in writing of the receipt of any such material

or containers or sewing twine, quoting the indent number, within seven days after receipt thereof.

NOTE.—Schedule 'A' refers to indents for own account only, and Schedule 'B' to indents for account of third parties. Schedule 'C' must also be rendered by importers of the materials mentioned, not later than the 7th of each month in respect of the immediately preceding month.

3. Every person, except a *bona fide* farmer for his own use, who owns or has power to dispose of, or is in possession or control of, or whose business or part of whose business it is to produce or sell in the Territory, any jute or hessian material or containers or sewing twine, shall, not later than the 7th day of each month, render a duly completed return in the form prescribed in Schedule 'C' hereto, reflecting the true position as at the end of the immediately preceding month in respect of his purchase, sales and stocks of materials or containers or sewing twine mentioned in that Schedule.

4. Any person who holds, controls or sells any material or containers or sewing twine, as aforesaid, at more than one place or business premises in the Territory, shall render separate returns in respect of each such place or premises, unless otherwise authorised by the Controller.

5. The requirements of these regulations shall not apply—

- Sub by HCN. 65/43*
- (a) in so far as they relate to the various kinds of material mentioned in the Schedules hereto, in respect of any person who, during the calendar year 1942, handled in the aggregate 5,000 yards or less of all such materials;
 - (b) in so far as they relate to the various kinds of containers mentioned in those Schedules, in respect of any person who, during that calendar year, handled in the aggregate 1,000 units or less of all such containers;
 - (c) in so far as they relate to jute or hessian sewing twine, in respect of any person who, during that calendar year, handled in the aggregate 1,000 lb. or less of such twine."
