HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 342 of 1942.

CONTROL OF BUILDING MATERIALS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to revoke the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 121 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 159 of 1942, and to substitute the following regulations in lieu thereof:—

CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDMENT OF
REGULATIONS AFFECTING MERCHANTS,
IMPORTERS, MANUFACTURERS AND
CONTRACTORS.

1. In these regulations—

“ person ” shall include—

- (a) a local authority and a Government Department;
- (b) any company incorporated or registered as such under any law;
- (c) any body of persons, corporate or unincorporate;

“ prohibited stock ” shall mean that percentage of the total quantity of the goods enumerated in Schedules B and E hereto, or any amendment thereof, which is in the possession, control or upon the premises of a merchant on the 31st day of December, 1942, or which is acquired after the said date, as is specified in the last column of the said Schedules; provided that any goods enumerated in Schedules B and E hereto which were previously prohibited stock in terms of High Commissioner's Notice No. 121 of 1942, as amended, shall remain prohibited stock, except as specially provided in regulation 5 hereof;

“ unprohibited stock ” shall mean that portion of the total quantity of the said goods in the possession, control or on the premises of a merchant which does not constitute prohibited stock;

- “ merchant ” shall mean any person dealing within the Territory in the purchase, sale or supply of any goods specified in Schedules B and E hereto (or any amendment thereof), but shall not include any manufacturer or contractor as defined hereafter; *provided, however, that any person receiving any such goods from beyond the borders of the Territory shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of such goods;*
- “ manufacturer ” shall mean any person who is engaged, within the Territory, in the manufacture and the sale or supply exclusively to merchants of any of the goods specified in Schedules B and E hereto (or any amendment thereof). Any manufacturer who sells or disposes of any portion of such goods to persons other than merchants (except upon permit or certified order as provided in regulation 8 hereof) shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of that portion of such goods offered for sale or disposal to such persons;
- “ contractor ” shall mean any person carrying on within the Territory the regular business of undertaking the performance of work entailing the use by such person of any of the goods specified in Schedules B and E hereto (or any amendment thereof), and shall include any institution, company, firm or person undertaking the construction or maintenance and repair of any buildings or structures in its possession. Any contractor who sells or disposes of such goods otherwise than in the execution of works being carried out by such contractor shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of that portion of goods offered for sale or disposal. Any merchant or manufacturer who carries on the regular business of undertaking the performance of work entailing the use by such merchant or manufacturer of any such goods shall be considered as a contractor in respect of that portion of his business so conducted;
- “ goods ” shall mean any unused building material, article, equipment or fitting specified in the Schedules B and E hereto (or any amendment thereof);
- “ defence work ” shall mean any work or service being carried out by any Naval, Military or Air Force or by any Government Department, agent or contractor on behalf of such Force;
- “ authorised officer ” shall mean [for the purposes of paragraph (1) (a) of regulation 6 hereof] an officer or official under whose direction and control the defence works are being executed

and who is empowered to sign such certificate by any Naval, Military or Air Force or by any Government Department on behalf of such Force;

“ Controller ” shall mean the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

MERCHANTS AND IMPORTERS.

2. Every merchant shall, in respect of goods of which a return is required under regulation 4 hereof, separate that portion of the stock which constitutes prohibited stock from that portion which constitutes unprohibited stock.

3. Every merchant shall, in respect of each item of the goods specified in the Schedules and in respect of both the prohibited and unprohibited stock, keep the following records:—

- (i) the quantities in stock or under his control at the 2nd April, 1942;
- (ii) the quantities acquired after the said date and the dates and manner of such acquisitions; and
- (iii) the quantities disposed of by sale or otherwise after the said date in each calendar month.

4. Every merchant shall, in respect of the goods in his possession, control or upon his premises, make a monthly return, in duplicate, in the manner set out in the Form B. 1 (amended) attached hereto:

Provided that [except as required by regulation 6 (2) hereof] a return shall only be made in respect of any item of goods for which a previous return has been made, or where the total retail value of the stocks of such item on hand at the date to which the return refers or which have been received during the current month exceeds—

- (i) £10 (ten pounds) for items enumerated in Schedule B (or any amendment thereof); or
- (ii) £5 (five pounds) for items enumerated in Schedule E (or any amendment thereof).

Returns shall reflect the true position and shall be duly certified in the manner set out in the Form B. 1 (amended).

Returns shall be made in respect of each calendar month, provided that the only information required in respect of any item of goods, of which no previous return has been made for reasons permissible under these regulations, shall be the details of stocks on hand.

Returns must reach the Controller on or before the 10th day of the month following that in respect of which the return is made.

The actual quantities of stocks on hand or received which represent the prescribed percentage shall be stated in the columns headed "Prohibited Stock" and "Unprohibited Stock" respectively in Form B. 1 (amended). Such quantities shall be stated in terms of the units of measurement prescribed in Schedules B and E, and the item number of each description of goods held must be indicated in the monthly return and must coincide with the number shown for those goods in Schedules B and E.

Total stocks manufactured during a month shall be those stocks of goods, if any, manufactured by the merchant making the return and offered by him for sale or disposal to persons other than merchants.

Total stocks imported during a month shall be those stocks of such imported goods, if any, received during such month.

Stocks on hand shall include the quantities on hand, in bond and in storage, also all stocks in transit within the Territory, but not stocks at any branch office. Merchants holding or controlling stocks at more than one point shall make separate returns in respect of each point.

Where there is more than one size or type mentioned against any item, these shall be grouped together for the purposes of these regulations.

Copies of Form B. 1 (amended) may be obtained from the Controller.

[NOTE.—Pending the printing of the new Form B. 1 (amended), merchants are required to use Forms B. 1 and themselves to insert the additional columns showing stock manufactured and imported during the current month as shown on the Form B. 1 (amended) attached to this Notice.]

5. Alterations to the prescribed percentage of prohibited stock in respect of goods previously enumerated in Schedules B and E to High Commissioner's Notice No. 121 of 1942, as amended, or future alterations to such percentages in any amendments to Schedules B and E hereto, shall be dealt with as follows:—

- (i) Where the percentage is *increased* to 100, the total unprohibited stocks on hand at the date of such increase of percentage shall be transferred to prohibited stock.
- (ii) Where the percentage is *decreased to nil*, the total prohibited stocks on hand at the date of such decrease of percentage shall be transferred to unprohibited stock, but returns shall nevertheless continue to be made in respect of such total unprohibited stock.

- (iii) Where the percentage is *increased* to a figure under 100, the requisite proportion of the unprohibited stock on hand at the date of such increase shall be transferred to prohibited stock, e.g., where the percentage is increased from 50 to 75, one-half (i.e., 25 out of 50) of the unprohibited stock shall be so transferred.
- (iv) Where the percentage is *decreased* to a figure above *nil*, the requisite proportion of the prohibited stock on hand at that date of such decrease shall be transferred to unprohibited stock, e.g., where the percentage is decreased from 75 to 50, one-third (i.e., 25 out of 75) of the prohibited stock shall be so transferred.

6. (1) No merchant who deals in any goods specified in the Schedules shall, as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, dispose of any prohibited stock except—

- (a) In fulfilment of a written order endorsed with a certificate by an authorised officer in the following form:—

“ I certify that the goods specified in this order are required for *Defence Works*.

(Official stamp.)

(Signature).....

Rank or Designation of
Authorised Officer.”

Each order shall be submitted in duplicate by a contractor, agent or official to the Officer-in-Charge of the Defence Works, who shall retain one copy of each certified order for the purpose of record and checking the delivery and destination of the goods enumerated in the order.

No merchant shall refuse to supply the goods specified in the certified order if he has such goods in stock.

- (b) On the authority of and subject to the conditions of a permit issued by or on behalf of the Controller.

(2) Nothing contained in these regulations shall prevent a merchant (hereinafter called the “ seller ”) from selling or disposing of prohibited stock to another merchant (hereinafter called “ the purchaser ”) within the Territory, provided that—

- (i) prior to such sale or disposal the seller shall inform the purchaser that the goods are prohibited stock, and shall further satisfy himself that the purchaser reasonably anticipates being able to dispose of such prohibited stock to Defence Works or essential

services under certified order or permit as provided for in paragraph (1) of this regulation;

- (ii) the seller shall immediately notify the Controller in writing of the name and address of the merchant to whom the goods have been supplied, and shall state the Schedule item number, description and quantity of the goods. The seller shall further endorse the invoice relevant to such sale or disposal as follows:—

“ I/We certify that the goods specified in this invoice are ‘prohibited stock’ and shall not be sold or disposed of except in terms of regulation 6 of High Commissioner’s Notice No. 342 of 1942.”

The goods so sold or disposed of shall be shown in the next monthly return of the seller as prohibited stocks sold during the current month;

- (iii) no merchant shall so purchase or acquire prohibited stock from another merchant unless he has a permit or certified order for the disposal of such stock, or unless he reasonably anticipates being able to dispose of such prohibited stock to Defence Works or essential services under certified order or permit as provided for in paragraph (1) of this regulation; and
- (iv) the purchaser shall immediately notify the Controller in writing of the name and address of the seller, and shall state the Schedule item and number, description and quantity of the goods. The goods shall be shown in the next monthly returns of the purchaser as prohibited stock received during the current month, and shall not be disposed of by the purchaser except in terms of paragraph (1) of this regulation.

7. (1) Any merchant to whom the provisions of these regulations apply may dispose of any unprohibited stock provided that he satisfies himself that the goods to be disposed of are required for fulfilling the purchaser’s immediate and necessary requirements.

No purchaser shall acquire such goods except for such requirements.

(2) Nothing contained in these regulations shall prevent a merchant from selling or disposing of unprohibited stock in his possession or control to another merchant, provided that the merchant so disposing of such unprohibited stock shall endorse the invoice relevant to such sale or disposal as follows:—

“ I/We certify that the goods specified on this invoice are *ex* free stocks and may be sold or disposed of in terms of regulation 7 (1) of High Commissioner's Notice No. 342 of 1942. No return need be made in respect of these goods to the Controller.

Signature.....
Description.....”

The merchant so purchasing or acquiring unprohibited stock from another merchant shall not be required to make a return in respect thereof, but shall retain for record purposes the invoice relevant thereto, duly endorsed as set out above.

MANUFACTURERS.

8. As from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* no manufacturer shall sell or dispose of any goods in his possession or control for which a return is required in terms of regulation 10 hereof, except—

- (1) to a merchant; or
- (2) in fulfilment of an order endorsed by an authorised officer as provided for in terms of regulation 6 (1) (a) hereof; or
- (3) on the authority of and subject to the conditions of a permit issued by or on behalf of the Controller:

Provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent a manufacturer from dealing as a merchant and from converting the whole or any portion of the stocks of goods in his possession or control as a manufacturer into stocks of goods in his possession or control as a merchant, whereupon he shall be deemed to be a merchant in respect of that portion of the goods so converted.

9. As from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* no manufacturer shall sell or dispose of any goods in his possession or control to any company, firm or person who is not resident or whose place of business is not within the Territory, except on the authority of and subject to the conditions of a permit issued by or on behalf of the Controller, or on the authority of an export permit issued by or on behalf of the Controller of Imports and Exports.

10. Every manufacturer shall, in respect of the goods in his possession, control or upon his premises, make a monthly return in duplicate in the manner set out in the Form B. 100 (amended), attached hereto:

Provided that a return shall only be made in respect of any item of goods for which a previous return has been made, or where the total retail value of the stocks of such item on hand at the date to which the

for that purpose by the Controller, and a sample of such goods shall, if required, be deposited with the Controller.

14. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Controller may, in his discretion, grant exemption from the whole or any of the provisions of this Notice to any person or in respect of any item of the goods referred to herein.

15. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
