HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 344 of 1942.

CONTROL OF NON-FERROUS MATERIALS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit and order as follows:—

1. As from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, no person shall use lead for the manufacture of lead traps and/or lead piping save with the written consent of the Controller.

Any person desiring to obtain such consent shall furnish particulars showing—

- (a) the quantity of lead he desires to use;
- (b) the number and size of traps and/or the length, diameter, and weight of the piping he desires to manufacture;
- (c) the name and address of the person who has ordered such traps and/or piping from him, if any.

2. In these regulations "Controller" means the Government Secretary or such other Officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

3. Any person who contravenes any prohibition hereby imposed or who furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
