HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 44 OF 1942.

CONTROL OF RUBBER.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit the acquisition or disposal of any ~~used~~ rubber tyre, except as set forth in the Schedule to this Notice.

High Commissioner's Notice No. 23 of 1942 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE.

1. In this Schedule, unless inconsistent with the context—

“ rubber tyre ” means an unworn outer cover of a pneumatic tyre for use on the wheel of a vehicle;

“ Controller ” means the Government Secretary;

“ District Controller ” means and includes any officer appointed to be a District Controller of Petrol under the provisions of High Commissioner's Notice No. 19 of 1942.

2. No person shall sell or supply any rubber tyre except on the authority of a permit duly completed and signed by a District Controller in the form (Rubber 1) attached hereto:

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply in the case of —

(a) the sale or supply by wholesale dealers in and manufacturers of rubber tyres, to any person carrying on the business of assembling new motor vehicles, and for the sole purpose of such assembly;

(b) the sale or supply of rubber tyres for pedal cycles, infant perambulators, invalid chairs and such other vehicles as the Controller may from time to time determine;

(c) the sale or supply of rubber tyres which is specially permitted by the Controller in terms of Section 7 and of Clause (2) of Section 8 hereof.

3. Applications for permits must be submitted in the form (Rubber 2) attached hereto. A fee of sixpence in revenue stamps must accompany each application. A separate application must be made in respect of the tyres required for each vehicle.

4. An applicant must complete the application form, and the seller must complete the certificate appearing thereon before the application is submitted by the applicant, by hand or by post, to a District Controller.

5. Permits, if granted, will be delivered by the District Controller to the applicant, who must surrender the permit to the seller or supplier before the completion of the transaction. Permits endorsed by the seller or supplier, quoting the serial numbers of the tyres supplied and of the tyres handed in, must then be returned to the Controller.

6. A permit, other than a special permit mentioned in Section 7 hereunder, shall be valid only for a period of ~~seven~~ days from the date of issue, and shall not be transferable.

7. The Controller may, in his discretion and subject to such conditions as he may impose (including the payment of fees), issue special permits to any person or body operating ten or more vehicles for national, public or business purposes.

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Schedule—

(1) ~~a seller may~~, in the event of an emergency in the course of a journey, supply tyres to an applicant, provided—

(a) the applicant completes an application form and the seller completes the certificate appearing thereon;

(b) the applicant and the seller complete the supplementary declaration appearing on page 2 of the application form;

(c) the seller submits such completed application, together with the fee of sixpence in revenue stamps, to a District Controller on the following working day; and

(d) the seller completes and returns the permit, which will be issued by the District Controller in respect of the transaction, as required in the second sentence of Section 5 hereof;

(2) the conditions prescribed in this Schedule may be varied or superseded at the discretion of the Controller in other special or exceptional circumstances, or cases, and the Controller may vary the forms prescribed herein.

9. (a) If an applicant for a permit furnishes any false information in connection with any application, the Controller or a District Controller may refuse such application and any future applications made by or on behalf of the person appearing on the application form as the registered owner.

(b) If a seller or supplier of rubber tyres furnishes any false information in connection with any application, the Controller may prohibit the future supply of tyres to the seller or supplier.

10. Any permit or special permit issued in terms of High Commissioner's Notice No. 23 of 1942 by the Resident Commissioner or by an officer duly authorised by him shall be valid and remain of full force and effect as if granted in terms of this Notice.

11. Any person who contravenes any prohibition hereby imposed or any person who knowingly furnishes the Controller or a District Controller with any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
