**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE**

No. 52 of 1942.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 227 of 1941, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 13 of 1942, dealing with the Control of Exports, by adding after item (xxviii) in sub-paragraph (a) of the first paragraph the following new items:—

- (xxix) Linseed oil.
- (xxx) Turpentine.
- (xxxi) Glycerine products.
- (xxxii) Potassium salts.
- (xxxiii) Caustic soda.
- (xxxiv) Liquid Chlorine.
- (xxxv) Glue.
- (xxxvi) Rennet.
- (xxxvii) Bags (new and second-hand) (except paper and leather bags); and bagging and sacking.
- (xxxviii) Bottles.
- (xxxix) Bones and bone meal.
- (xl) Fertilizers (including meat meal, fish meal and blood meal).
- (xli) Paper.
- (xlii) Dental goods.
- (xliii) Drugs and medical preparations.
- (xliv) Rubber and rubber manufactures.
- (xlv) Rope: manilla, hemp, etc.
- (xlvi) Lead products.
- (xlvii) Electrodes.
- (xlviii) Leather and leather products.
- (xlix) Electric fittings.
  - (i) Diamonds (cut and polished).
  - (ii) Explosives.
  - (iii) Onions.
  - (iiii) Potatoes.
  - (liv) Kaffir-corn.
  - (lv) Barley.
  - (lvi) Canned vegetables.
  - (lvii) Groundnuts.
  - (lviii) Eggs.
  - (lix) Lucerne hay and meal.
  - (lx) Power paraffin.
  - (lxi) Binder twine and sewing twine.
  - (lxii) Lubricating oils.
  - (lxiii) Tin and products containing tin.
