**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 57 of 1942.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section one of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section one of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section one of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 44 of 1942 to the extent set out in the Schedule appended hereto.

SCHEDULE.

1. Section 1 of the Schedule to the said Notice is hereby amended by inserting the words "including any retreaded, recapped or reconditioned tyre" between the words "tyre" and "for" in the definition of "rubber tyre".

2. Section 2 of the Schedule to the said Notice is hereby amended by—

(1) the addition of the following new sub-paragraph (d):—

"(d) the sale or supply of rubber tyres for the completion of the manufacture or assembly of trailers or animal-drawn vehicles."

(2) the addition of the following further proviso:—

"Provided further that no person shall acquire more than one reasonably serviceable rubber tyre in excess of the number of running wheels (i.e. excluding spare wheels) of his vehicle."
