CONTROL OF RUBBER.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the subjoined Regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Every person who owns or has power to dispose of or is in possession or control of any raw or other cured or uncured rubber shall render a return in the form set out in Schedule A hereunder, save as provided in paragraph 7 hereof.

Provided that whenever this return is made by an owner who is not in possession or control of the rubber included therein, no other person shall make a return in respect of the same rubber.

2. This return must be submitted notwithstanding that the information called for, or part of it, may have been submitted prior to publication hereof, in compliance with the terms of paragraph 3 (i) and/or 4 (i) of High Commissioner's Notice No. 47 of 1942.

3. Every person having any raw or other cured or uncured rubber on indent but not yet arrived in the Territory, as at the 25th day of April, 1942, shall render a return in the form set out in Schedule B hereunder.

4. All returns must be completed to reflect the true position as at the 25th day of April, 1942, and must be returned to the Controller of Rubber not later than the 30th day of April, 1942.

5. Any person who subsequent to the 25th day of April, 1942, places any order for the supply of any raw or other cured or uncured rubber from a source outside the Territory, shall immediately upon placing the order, render a return in the form set out in Schedule B hereunder.

6. Persons holding stocks or controlling stocks at more than one point shall render separate returns for each point.

7. No returns need be made by the persons mentioned in paragraph 1 hereof whose total stocks as at the 25th day of April, 1942, of raw or other cured or uncured rubber do not exceed 100 pounds in weight, or whose stocks of liquid latex do not exceed 50 Imperial gallons.
