Letters: 1½d. per ½ oz.
Postcards: 1½d. each
Newspapers: ½d. per 4 oz. per copy. Limit of weight for each packet, 1 lb.
Printed papers: ½d. per 2 oz.
Commercial papers: ½d. per 2 oz.
Sample packets: ½d. per 2 oz.; minimum, 1d.
Parcels: 1s. 3d. per lb. (Ghanzi, 1s. 9d. per lb.; Kasane, 1s. per lb.).
