PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Motor Car
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1942.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Motor Car
(Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1929,
hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in
me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make
