58.	Tobacco, unmanufactured.
71.	Laces, lace curtaining and flouncing and embroidery in the piece or in the form of insertions or medallions.
79.	Shawls: cashmere, lace and silk, knitted and crocheted shawls, and other shawls weighing not more than 12 oz. each.
178.	Marble, including tombstones.
182.	Sculpture (including bronzes), being original works of art, or specially made reproductions thereof, modelled separately by an individual artist.
186.	Tiles: (b) Wall, earthenware (all colours).
226.	Extracts for perfumery, n.e.e.
269. (g)	Venetian blinds.
275.	Shingles, wooden.
285. (d)	Paper drinking and soufflé cups and ice-cream cups and jars.
288.	Cards, playing.
294.	Paintings, etchings, pictures, including calendar mounts on which a picture is imprinted, lithographed or embossed with or without a decorative border or margin, and not forming nor intended to form part of any imported printed, lithographed or embossed matter otherwise provided for, and picture books.
296. (a)	Picture post cards: Christmas, birthday, pictorial, New Year and other cards; box-coverings and pictures intended to form part of imported printed, lithographed or embossed matter.
324.	Cameras for private use.
328. (1)	Specimens illustrative of natural history and exhibits for public museums or other institutions to which the public have free access or for scientific purposes.
(2)	Antiques and works of art, provided they were produced or manufactured more than one hundred years prior to the date of importation under such conditions as the Resident Commissioner may prescribe.
335.	Second-hand magazines and periodicals, i.e., over-issue and/or used magazines and periodicals imported in bulk, paper festoon decoration, confetti and cracker carnival novelties, fancy wrapping and tissue wrapping papers, decorative cardboard containers drinking straws
