BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE DEFENCE
(FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

EXEMPTION OF EXPORTS TO COUNTRIES IN THE
STERLING AREA FROM THE PROVISIONS OF
REGULATION 5 (10) (a).

The Resident Commissioner, by virtue of the powers conferred upon him by sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (10) of Regulation 5, hereby exempts exports to the following countries from the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of the said paragraph:—

Any part of the British Commonwealth of Nations, excluding Canada and Newfoundland, any territory in respect of which a mandate on behalf of the League of Nations is being exercised by the Government of the United Kingdom or of any Dominion, Egypt, the Anglo-Egyptian Sudan, Iraq, Belgian Congo and Ruanda Urundi, Iceland, Faroe Islands, French Equatorial Africa, French Camerouns, French Oceania and French establishments in India.

Exporters are accordingly not required to complete the Declaration of Foreign Exchange Proceeds of Exports in respect of exports to the countries specified above.
