GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 6 OF 1943.

CONTROL OF BUILDING.

Under the powers vested in me by regulations 3 and 4 of the Annexure to High Commissioner's Notice No. 199 of 1942, I, WALTER GERARD BRIND, Building Controller, do hereby prohibit, regulate and order as follows:—

1. In this Notice the terms "building" and "cost" shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Annexure to High Commissioner's Notice No. 199 of 1942.

2. Sub-regulation (b) of regulation 7 appearing in Government Notice No. 29 of 1942 shall be deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

7. (b) any building or addition to any building the cost of which will not exceed or is not likely to exceed £100, provided that this exemption shall not apply where any building or addition to any building has been erected on the same site, erf, stand or lot within the preceding twelve months.
