HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 105 of 1943.

CONTROL OF NON-FERROUS METALS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to order as follows:—

The regulations set forth in High Commissioner's Notice No. 245 of 1942 are hereby amended by the deletion of regulation 6, which reads as follows:—

“ 6. No person shall use tin from sources outside South Africa in the manufacture of solders, type metals (stereo. metal, mono. metal, lino. metal), anti-friction metals or other alloys, save with the written consent of the Controller.”
