HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

CONTROL OF BUILDING MATERIALS.
AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS AFFECTING
CONTRACTORS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to revoke paragraph (1) of regulation 11 appearing in High Commissioner's Notice No. 342 of 1942 and to substitute the following paragraph therefor:—

“(1) in the regular course of his business of undertaking the performance of work entailing the use of such goods, provided however that—

(a) no goods in respect of which the prohibited percentage prescribed in the Schedules B and E hereto (or any amendment thereof) is 100, shall be so used for the erection of any building or Utility Service or the alteration, addition or repair to any existing building or addition to any Utility Service which is controlled in terms of the regulations appearing in Basutoland Government Notice No. 21 of 1942, Bechuanaland Protectorate Government Notice No. 29 of 1942 or Swaziland Government Notice No. 31 of 1942, as the case may be, *unless* a permit has been issued by or on behalf of the Controller for such erection, alteration, addition or repair; and

(b) no contractor undertaking the erection of any building or Utility Service or the alteration, addition or repair of any existing building or addition to any Utility Service for which a building permit has been issued by or on behalf of the Controller in terms of the regulations appearing in Basutoland Government Notice No. 21 of 1942, Bechuanaland Protectorate Government Notice No. 29 of 1942 or Swaziland Government Notice No. 31 of 1942, as the case may be, shall use, for such erection, alteration, addition or repair, any of the goods listed on such building permit other than, or in excess of, the quantities of such goods specifically allowed in such building permit.”
