HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 147 OF 1943.

CONTROL OF GLASSWARE AND HOUSEHOLD
REQUISITES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of glassware and household requisites in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland, each of which is hereinafter respectively referred to as "the Territory":—

1. In these regulations unless inconsistent with the context—

"exporter" means any person whose business or part of whose business it is to export from the Territory any of the articles or materials detailed in the Schedule hereto;

"importer" means any person whose business or part of whose business it is to import into the Territory any of the articles or materials detailed in the Schedule hereto, and shall include an indent agent;

"manufacturer" means any person whose business or part of whose business it is to manufacture any of the articles or materials detailed in the Schedule hereto;

"merchant" means any person whose business or part of whose business it is to sell or otherwise dispose of any of the materials or articles detailed in the Schedule hereto to any other person;

“ Controller ” means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

2. Every merchant shall submit to the Controller a return of the stocks on hand and the outstanding indents of such merchant as at the 31st July, 1943, in respect of the materials and articles detailed in the Schedule hereto, on a form as set out in Annexure “ A ”, giving the quantities in excess of the quantities detailed in brackets in each item of the said Annexure “ A ”. Every such return shall be rendered not later than the 15th of August, 1943.

3. (1) Every importer shall submit not later than the 15th day of every month a return in respect of all articles and materials detailed in the Schedule hereto imported by such importer during the preceding month, in the form set out in Annexure “ B ”.

(2) Every importer shall render the first return in terms of sub-regulation (1) in respect of all imports of articles and materials detailed in the Schedule hereto, on or after the 1st August, 1943, to the Controller not later than the 15th September, 1943.

4. (1) Every manufacturer shall submit a return to the Controller not later than the 15th day of every month in respect of the total number of articles detailed in the Schedule hereto, manufactured by him during the preceding month, in the form set out in Annexure “ C ”.

(2) Every manufacturer shall render the first return in terms of sub-regulation (1) in respect of the articles detailed in the Schedule hereto, manufactured during the month of August, not later than the 15th September, 1943.

(3) Every manufacturer shall further render a return to the Controller not later than the 15th August, 1943, of the stocks on hand as at 31st July, 1943, in respect of the articles detailed in the Schedule hereto, giving the quantities of such articles by completing columns (1) and (2) of Annexure “ A ”.

(4) Every manufacturer who manufactures any of the articles detailed in the Schedule hereto shall submit a list to the Controller showing which of the articles in the Schedule he manufactures, not later than the 22nd August, 1943.

5. (1) Every exporter shall render a return to the Controller not later than the 15th day of every month of the total number of articles exported by him during the preceding month in the form set out in Annexure “ D ”.

(2) Every exporter shall render the first return in terms of sub-regulation (1) in respect of materials and articles detailed in the Schedule hereto, exported by him during the month of August, not later than the 15th September, 1943.

6. Any person who refuses or neglects to comply with the requirements of these regulations may be disqualified from participation in the distribution of any available supplies of the materials and articles detailed in the Schedule hereto in the future.

7. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

NOTE.—All merchants should submit a return, even though the quantities in stock fall short of the figures shown in brackets on the Schedule hereto.

Furthermore no forms for returns will be provided.
