HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 150 of 1943.

CONTROL OF RUBBER.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 30 of 1943 as follows:—

1. Regulation 2 is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the definition of " District Controller ", the following further definition:—

" ' qualified dealer ' means any person who carries on the business of the reconditioning and/or the sale of rubber tyres; "

2. Regulation 3 is hereby amended by deleting the words—

" No person shall sell or supply any rubber tyre or retread a tyre, and no person shall acquire a rubber tyre "

and substituting therefor the following words:—

" No person shall retread a tyre or sell, let or supply in any manner whatsoever any rubber tyre, and no person shall acquire possession of any rubber tyre by purchase, hire, gift or in any other manner whatsoever "
