HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 152 of 1943.

CONTROL OF MACHINE AND SMALL TOOLS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the disposal of certain machine and small tools in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

1. In these regulations—

“ open permit ” means a permit issued by the Controller authorising a person to sell or otherwise dispose of the machine tools detailed in the Schedule hereto generally, in the ordinary course of business, without the necessity for obtaining a special permit in respect of every specific sale or disposal of such machine tools;

“ Controller ” means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

2. No other person shall, as from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, sell or dispose of any of the tools whether new or used, as detailed in the Schedule hereto, except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions of an open permit issued by the Controller, or by an officer duly authorised to act on his behalf, provided that no permit shall be required for the sale of used files.

3. Applications for open permits for the sale or disposal of tools detailed in the Schedule hereto must be made in writing to the Controller.

4. No permits are required for the purchase or acquisition of tools as detailed in the Schedule hereto. Persons desiring to purchase or acquire such tools should approach their suppliers in the usual way and should not make application to the Controller.

5. Every person who has in his possession any of the tools detailed in the Schedule hereto, whether new or used, for purpose of sale, shall make a return of such tools held in stock by him on the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*. Returns shall be submitted to the Controller within one month from the date of publication of this notice, provided that no returns need be rendered in respect of used files.

6. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

SCHEDULE.

Band sawblades; log frame sawblades; circular solid rip sawblades; circular solid crosscut sawblades; circular swage sawblades; inserted tooth circular sawblades; inserted teeth; holders for teeth; other sawblades of any type and not specified above; machine knives; high speed steel faced, mild steel backed, cutter steel in lengths, micrometer ground to size; tenon and shoulder cutters; morticing chains; guide bars for morticing chains; sprockets for morticing chains; hollow chisels; augers for hollow chisels; moulding cutters; morticing bits; machine boring augers; dovetail cutters; other cutters not specified above; bandsaw guides; spare sideplates and rollers for bandsaw guides; track bands for bandsaw pulleys; cutter bolts, all sizes; loose cutterblocks, all sizes; trenching heads, solid and expanding; triangular machine bandsaw files; millsaw files.
