HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 175 of 1943.

CONTROL OF MACHINE AND SMALL TOOLS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 152 of 1943 (hereinafter referred to as "the said regulations") as follows:—

1. Regulation 1 of the said regulations is hereby amended by deleting the definition of "open permit" and substituting therefor the following definition:—

"'open permit' means a permit issued by the Controller authorising a person to sell or otherwise dispose of in the ordinary course of his business the tools and equipment used in conjunction with power-driven wood-working machines and the special files listed in the Schedule hereto, without the necessity of obtaining a special permit in respect of every specific sale or disposal of such articles."

2. The date when the return required by regulation 5 of the said regulations has to be rendered is hereby extended to a date not later than one month from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.
