HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 18 of 1943.

CONTROL OF GRAIN MILLING MACHINERY
SPARES AND REQUISITES.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of grain milling machinery spares and requisites in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

1. No person shall sell or otherwise dispose of any description of silk bolting cloth or grit gauze or wire mesh made of steel or non-ferrous metal of not less than 20 meshes to the linear inch, to any other person except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions set forth in a permit issued by the Controller or by an officer authorised by him to act on his behalf.

2. No person shall manufacture or sell or otherwise dispose of any article containing silk bolting cloth or grit gauze, or wire mesh made of steel or non-ferrous metal of not less than 20 meshes to the linear inch, except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions set forth in a permit issued by the Controller or by an officer authorised by him to act on his behalf.

3. Applications for permits in terms of these regulations must be made in writing to the Controller, and must contain the following information:—

- (a) Name and address of the person to whom it is proposed to sell or otherwise dispose of the material or article.
- (b) Use for which the material or article is required.

- (c) Description of the material, viz., length, breadth, the number of meshes per linear inch, and the trade description of the material and/or description of article.
- (d) Stock on hand of the material or article to be disposed of at date of application.

4. In these regulations " Controller " means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

5. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations, or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
