HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 196 OF 1943.

CONTROL OF AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS,
MACHINERY AND REQUISITES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 144 of 1942 as follows:—

(a) By the deletion in regulation 3 (c) of the phrase " 1 to 12 " wherever it occurs and by the substitution therefor of the phrase " 1 to 25 ";

(b) by the addition to Part III of Schedule A to the said regulations of the following items:—

18. Cream and milk cans.
19. Landsides.
20. Planter runners.
21. Cultivator points.
22. Cultivator sweeps.
23. Cultivator shovels.
24. Horse, mule and donkey shoes.
25. Pump cylinders (for sale separately).
26. Horse shoe nails.
27. Sheep shears.
28. Orange clippers.
29. Bull rings.
30. Sickles.
31. Hay knives.
32. Cane knives.
33. Native hoes.
34. Pruning shears.
35. Pruning knives.
36. Scythes.
37. Cattle stanchions.
38. Cattle stanchion fittings.

NOTE.—For the purpose of resale items 18 to 25 have now been added and may not be disposed of except under the authority of a permit issued by the Controller. No permit is required for the resale of items 26 to 38, but stocks thereof must figure in monthly returns as provided for in High Commissioner's Notice No. 144 of 1942.
