HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 20 OF 1943.

CONTROL OF USED OIL.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of used oil in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

1. In these regulations—

“ used oil ” means used lubricant collected from engines and machinery;

“ lubricant ” means any substance capable of use as such and containing oil (excluding petrol and any other substance suitable for use in an internal combustion engine), or fat (excluding butter).

2. No person shall acquire used oil except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions set forth in a permit issued by the Controller or by an officer authorised by him to act on his behalf.

Applications for permits in terms of this regulation shall be made in writing to the Controller, accompanied by the following information, which shall be certified by the applicant as true and correct:—

- (i) Name and address of applicant.
- (ii) Name and address of supplier.
- (iii) Quantity of used oil to be acquired.
- (iv) Purpose for which such oil is to be used.

3. No person shall dispose of used oil to any other person unless the latter person produces a permit issued to him in terms of regulation 2 hereof.

4. No person shall use any used oil as an ingredient in the manufacture or production of any commodity other than a lubricant.

5. The provisions of these regulations shall not apply to the acquisition, disposal or use of quantities of used oil of two gallons or less.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations the Controller may, in his discretion, grant exemption from all or any of the provisions thereof to any person.

7. In these regulations " Controller " means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

8. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
