CONTROL OF TEXTILES.

THE MAKING OF CIVILIAN CLOTHING.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 7 of 1943 as follows:—

1. By the insertion of the words "and dinner jacket" after the words "lounge jacket" in column 1 of item 1 (*b*) of the Schedule to the said regulations.

2. By the deletion of the words "metal or leather buttons" from the fifth and sixth lines of column 2 of item 1 (*d*) of the said Schedule.

3. By the deletion of the words "more than two pockets" from the fourth line of column 2 of item 1 (*e*) of the said Schedule.

4. By the deletion of the words "permanent turn-ups, except shorts; pleats" from the fourth and fifth lines of column 2 of item 1 (*f*) of the said Schedule.

5. By the deletion of item 1 (*k*) from the said Schedule and the substitution therefor of the following new item 1 (*k*):—

"Dress suits (tailcoats) . . . not to be made."
