HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 21 of 1943.

CONTROL OF NON-FERROUS MATERIALS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit and order as follows:—

1. As from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, no person shall use any sheet lead for any damp-proof course, gutter, flashing or flat roof in any building, save with the written consent of the Controller of Non-Ferrous Materials.

NOTE.—Such consent will not be granted unless documentary evidence that construction of the building has been authorised by the Building Controller is furnished to the Controller of Non-Ferrous Materials, and/or proof is forthcoming that no suitable substitute for sheet lead is available.

2. In these regulations “ Controller of Non-Ferrous Materials ” means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

3. Any person who contravenes any prohibition hereby imposed or who furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
