HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 212 OF 1943.

CONTROL OF USED OIL.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend with effect from 1st October, 1943, the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 20 of 1943, hereinafter referred to as "the said regulations", as follows:—

1. By the addition to regulation 1 of the said regulations of the following definition:—

" "reseller" means any person who sells lubricants by retail."

2. By the deletion of regulation 5 of the said regulations and the substitution therefor of the following new regulation 5:—

" Notwithstanding the provisions of these regulations any person who is a farmer may acquire used oil for use exclusively in his farming operations from a reseller upon furnishing the reseller with a written declaration in the form set out in the Annexure to this Notice."

3. By the addition to the said Notice of the Annexure to this Notice.
