HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 218 of 1943.

CONTROL OF SACCHARINE.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations for the control of saccharine:—

1. In these regulations—

“ person ” means any company, firm or institution;

“ Controller ” shall mean the Principal Medical Officer.

2. As from the date of publication of this notice no person shall sell or supply to any other person, or use for manufacture, saccharine in any form except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions set forth in a permit issued by the Controller.

3. Every person who, at the date of publication of this notice, owns or has in his possession or control saccharine in excess of 500 tablets of $\frac{1}{4}$ grain each, or an equivalent quantity, or 1 ounce weight of powder, shall within a period of 10 days from such date render a return of the stocks held by him at the date of such return to the Controller, giving the following information:—

(a) Quantity of stock on hand.

(b) Quantities of outstanding orders placed with overseas exporters.

(c) Numbers and dates of Certificates of Essentiality or Import Permits in respect of orders mentioned under (b) hereof.

4. Applications for permits, and returns in terms of these regulations shall be addressed to the Controller.
