HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 224 of 1943.

NOTICE TO ALL IMPORTERS AND DISTRI-  
BUTORS OF CREAM AND MILK CANS.

In terms of High Commissioner's Notice No. 196 of 1943, whereby cream and milk cans have been added to the list of articles mentioned in Part III of Schedule A to High Commissioner's Notice No. 144 of 1942, it has been decided to institute control of the sale of all cream and milk cans.

The basis upon which purchase and distribution of such articles will be established will be largely influenced by the amount of business done by importers and wholesale distributors during the years 1939 to 1942 inclusive.

It will, therefore, be necessary for all persons wishing to participate in the wholesale distribution of cream and milk cans to complete a return in the form of the Annexure hereto and forward it to the Controller of Agricultural Implements, Machinery and Requisites, appointed under High Commissioner's Notice No. 186 of 1943, within 15 days of the date of publication of this notice.

The return above mentioned must be supplemented by a statement in writing furnishing the following information:—

What portion of purchases for each year during the period 1939 to 1942 inclusive and during 1943 up to the 30th September were approximately for—

- (a) sale to other wholesalers;
- (b) sale to retailers;
- (c) sale to creameries and cheese factories;
- (d) sale to farmers direct.
