HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 226 of 1943.

CONTROL OF GLASSWARE AND HOUSEHOLD  
REQUISITES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 220 of 1943 as follows:—

1. By the deletion of the words “ the 1st November of each succeeding year ” in regulations 9 and 11 and the substitution therefor of the words “ the 20th October of each and every succeeding year ”.

2. By the deletion of the words “ on or before the 30th November, 1943, and on or before the 30th November of each succeeding year ” in regulation 13 and the substitution therefor of the words “ on or before the 15th November, 1943, and on or before the 20th October of each and every succeeding year ”.

3. Regulation 14 is hereby deleted and the following regulation is substituted therefor:—

“ 14. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any by-law or regulation of any local authority, no person who in the ordinary course of his trade or business delivers milk contained in a milk bottle to any other person shall leave such milk bottle in the possession or custody or on the premises of such other person;

(2) Every person to whom milk contained in a milk bottle is delivered shall, immediately upon such delivery, either empty such milk bottle and return it to the person who delivered the milk or provide a container other than a milk bottle into which the milk shall then and there be poured;

(3) Every person by whom milk contained in a milk bottle has been delivered to any other person shall immediately upon such bottle being emptied remove such bottle from the premises of such other person; provided that subject to the provisions of regulation 15 of these regulations, when not less than eight pints of milk contained in milk bottles

are delivered at any one time to a retail shopkeeper, general dealer, restaurant or tearoom for distribution or sale, the purchaser or recipient of the milk may retain the bottles in his possession until the supplier collects such bottles."

4. Items 7 and 8 of Annexure "A" are hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:—

"7. Stock of empty bottles or containers on hand, 30th September last.....(dozen)."

"8. Stock of full bottles or containers on hand, 30th September last.....(dozen)."

5. Item 10 of Annexure "A" is hereby deleted.

6. The heading of the third column of Annexure "B" is hereby deleted and the following new heading substituted therefor:—

*"Stock on hand at 30th September last. (Empty and full containers to be shown separately.)"*

7. The words "at date of application" in item 5 of Annexure "C" are hereby deleted, and the words "at 30th September last" substituted therefor.
