HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 233 OF 1943.

CONTROL OF SACCHARINE.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations for the control of saccharine:

1. Regulation 2 of High Commissioner's Notice No. 218 of 1943 is hereby cancelled.

2. In this Notice—

“ Controller ” means the Principal Medical Officer;

“ dealer ” means any person who in the course of trade or business sells saccharine;

“ person ” means any company, firm or person and includes any medical or sick benefit society or association which operates its own dispensaries.

3. As from the date of publication of this notice no person shall use saccharine in any form in the manufacture of any commodity except upon the authority and subject to the conditions set forth in a permit issued by the Controller.

4. As from the date of publication of this notice no person shall sell, supply or otherwise dispose of saccharine in any form except to a person who has obtained from the Controller a permit in writing entitling such person to obtain saccharine; provided that no permit shall be required for the supply of saccharine—

(i) by one dealer to another dealer;

(ii) by a dealer to a hospital or nursing home.

5. Every person who supplies saccharine upon the authority of a permit issued under these regulations shall endorse on such permit the quantity of saccharine so supplied and the date of such supply.

6. Every person who supplies saccharine in accordance with the provisions of regulation 4 of these regulations shall keep a register showing in respect of each transaction—

(a) name and address of person to whom saccharine was supplied;

(b) number of permit on the authority of which supply was made;

(c) date of supply;

(d) quantity supplied.

7. Every dealer who sells, supplies or disposes of saccharine in accordance with the proviso to regulation 4 of these regulations shall, on or before the 5th day of every month render to the Controller a return giving the following information:—

(a) Dealers, hospitals or nursing homes to whom saccharine was supplied during the preceding month;

(b) quantity of saccharine supplied;

(c) date of supply.

8. Every application for a permit in terms of these regulations must be made in writing to the Controller and must, if made by a person mentioned in regulation 4 hereof, be accompanied by proof that the applicant is either a sufferer from diabetes or that the supply to such person of saccharine is justified on other medical grounds, which must be specified.
