HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 25 of 1943.

CONTROL OF NON-FERROUS MATERIALS

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 155 of 1942, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 290 of 1942, by the insertion after regulation 6A of the following regulation numbered 6B:—

“ 6B. (a) Every person supplying any material against a permit issued in terms of regulations 2 and 6 hereof shall endorse on the back of such permit his name and address, the quantity and name of the material supplied and the date of delivery.

(b) The person who supplies the full quantity of material authorised by such a permit, or who supplies such a quantity of material which, if added to any quantity of material already supplied on such permit, completes the total quantity authorised by the permit, shall retain the permit and return it to the Controller with his monthly statement of disposals rendered in terms of regulation 3A.

(c) No person shall supply any quantity of material on any such permit, in excess of the quantity of the said material authorised by such permit, or which, if added to the quantity of material already supplied on the authority of the said permit, will cause the total quantity authorised by such permit to be exceeded.”
