**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 4 of 1943.**

**CONTROL OF PAPER.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively. His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of paper in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

1. Any company, firm or person to whom a "bulk" permit to import paper has been issued shall, before placing any order for the purchase of any paper under the authority of such permit, obtain the prior consent of the Controller for such purchase. Any purchases made without the prior consent of the Controller will render the permit holder liable to the cancellation of his "bulk" permit.

2. Every company, firm or person having on order from overseas any of the undermentioned types of paper shall, on or before the 30th January, 1943, render to the Controller a return in respect of each such type of paper, in the form set out in the Annexure hereto:—

Flat newsprint: MF, SC and other printings, white; MF, SC and other printings, tinted; art paper; imitation art white; imitation art tinted; MG poster; litho varnish; cartridge papers; cream laid and wove; tinted laid and wove; white bonds and banks, substance large post 13 lb. and over; white bonds and banks, substance under large post 13 lb.; tinted bonds and banks; white I.V.P.; tinted I.V.P.; ledger and a/c book papers; gummed; greaseproof; vegetable parchment; tissues; cover papers; manilas; printers' boards; bookbinders' boards; mfg. envelope cream woves and laids; mfg. envelope linen faced; mfg. envelope manilas; mfg. manilas; mfg. cream laids; mfg. linen faced; blotting paper; flints; chromo paper; papers not elsewhere enumerated (specify).

NOTE.—This return must be made by every company, firm or person who is a *principal* in a contract with overseas suppliers of the paper shown in the return, i.e., the actual importer.

3. All returns must be addressed to the Controller. All quantities must be expressed in short tons and/or decimal points thereof.

4. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations, or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

5. In these regulations "Controller" means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.
