HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 5 of 1943.**

**CONTROL OF PAPER.**

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of paper in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

1. Every company, firm or person holding stocks of paper aggregating 1,000 lb. or more, or having stocks of paper on order shall render a return in the form (Form P.C. 1) set out in the Annexure hereto of such stocks, as disclosed by physical stocktaking or as extracted from books certified by auditors as correct.

For the purpose of such returns "paper" shall mean all types of paper, including cardboard, paper-board, strawboard and the like; cellophane, rayophane, sidac, diaphane and all classes of cellulose film.

Returns are *not* required in respect of printed forms or stationery for own consumption, or in respect of printed books of all kinds.

For the purpose of the said returns, stocks of paper must be grouped in the following order:—

**GROUP I.—PRINTERS' PAPERS AND PRINTERS' BOARDS  
AND PAPERS FOR STATIONERY MANUFACTURE.**

- (1) Flat newsprint.
- (2) M.F., S.C. and other printings, white.
- (3) M.F., S.C. and other printings, tinted.
- (4) Art paper.
- (5) Imitation art white.
- (6) Imitation art tinted.
- (7) M.G. poster.
- (8) Litho varnish.
- (9) Cartridge papers.
- (10) Cream laid and wove.
- (11) Tinted laid and wove.
- (12) White bonds and banks. (Substance large post 13 lb. and over.)
- (13) White bonds and banks. (Substance under large post 13 lb.)
- (14) Tinted bonds and banks. (Substance under large post 13 lb. and over.)

- (15) Tinted bonds and banks. (Substance under large post 13 lb.)
- (16) White I.V.P.
- (17) Tinted I.V.P.
- (18) Ledger and account book papers.
- (19) Gummed.
- (20) Greaseproof/Glassine.
- (21) Vegetable parchment.
- (22) Tissues.
- (23) Cover papers.
- (24) Manilas.
- (25) Printers' boards.
- (26) Bookbinders' boards.
- (27) Manufacturing envelope cream woves and laids.
- (28) Manufacturing envelope linen faced.

- (33) Blotting papers.
- (34) Flints.

GROUP II.—WRAPPING PAPERS, FLAT, FOLDED OR ROLLS. (NOT ELSEWHERE ENUMERATED.)

- (1) Transparent cellulose of cellophane type.
- (2) Waxed papers.
- (3) Kraft.
- (4) Greaseproof and Glassine.
- (5) M.G. cap and sulphite tissue.

GROUP III.—INDUSTRIAL PAPERS AND BOARDS. (NOT ELSEWHERE ENUMERATED.)

- (1) Paper for bag-making (kraft, etc.).
- (2) Greaseproof and Glassine for bag-making.
- (3) Vegetable parchment for bag-making.
- (4) Transparent cellulose of cellophane type for bag-making.
- (5) Paper for explosives.
- (6) Kraft for cement bags.
- (7) Paper for manufacture of corrugated containers.
- (8) Paper for manufacture of toilet rolls.
- (9) Gummed paper tape for sealing corrugated or solid containers.
- (10) Box and carton boards.
- (11) Boards for manufacture of solid containers.
- (12) Cigarette paper hobbins.
- (13) Cork tipping for cigarettes.
- (14) Filter tipping materials for cigarettes.
- (15) Paper for manufacture of "Mono" type of containers.

- (16) Board for manufacture of " Mono " type of containers.
- (17) Pulp for paper making.
- (18) Papers not elsewhere enumerated (specify).

2. Returns on Form P.C. 5 must reach the Controller by twelve noon on Saturday, the 13th day of February, 1943, and must be clearly written or typed on paper not exceeding 13 inches by 16 inches in size (use both sides of paper).

NOTE.—*No forms will be supplied.*

3. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these regulations, or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

4. In these regulations " Controller " means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.
