HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 61 OF 1943.

DEFENCE REGULATIONS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following further amendment in the Bechuanaland Protectorate Defence Regulations, 1939, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations", published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 150 of 1939:—

The following Regulation, numbered 14A, is hereby inserted immediately after Regulation 14 of Chapter II of the principal Regulations:—

" 14A. (1) No person shall, except under the authority of a permit granted by or on behalf of the Resident Commissioner, publish, sell or communicate to any other person any photograph, sketch, plan or other document containing a view, record or description of any area in the Territory specified by the Resident Commissioner in terms of paragraph (1) (b) of the last preceding regulation or of any portion of any area so specified, or of any aerodrome, military camp, parade ground, gun emplacement site, munition factory, military storehouse or other such place or object in the Territory or in the Union of South Africa, Basutoland or Swaziland, information regarding which would be likely to be of value to an enemy, or of any portion of the coast line of the Union of South Africa, the port and settlement of Walvis Bay and the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, or of any ship, vessel or watercraft of any description.

(2) Chemists, photographers, general dealers and others who undertake the developing of photographic films and the printing of photographs shall keep a record of the names and addresses of persons who hand in films for processing or negatives for the making of prints.

(3) Any chemist, photographer, general dealer or other person who receives for developing any film or for printing any negative which contains a view, the publication, sale or communication of which is prohibited under

paragraph 1 of this Regulation, shall forthwith send or hand such film or negative to the nearest District Commissioner and furnish the name and address of the person from whom the film or negative was received."
