

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 73 of 1943.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the provisions of Act No. 10 of 1911 of the Union of South Africa, as of force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to approve with effect from 1st April, 1943, of the postage rates on the classes of postal articles posted in the Bechuanaland Protectorate as set out below:—

- (a) Letters and postcards addressed to places in the Union of South Africa, Basutoland, Swaziland, Bechuanaland Protectorate and South West Africa: Letters, 2d. for the first ounce and 1d. for each additional ounce; postcards, 1d. each.
- (b) Letters addressed to places in Angola, French Equatorial Africa, French Cameroons, Belgian Congo, Mozambique, Nyasaland, Northern and Southern Rhodesia: 2d. for the first half-ounce and 1½d. for each additional half-ounce.
- (c) Letters addressed to other places in the British Commonwealth: 2d. for the first half-ounce and ½d. for each additional half-ounce.
