HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 76 of 1943.

CONTROL OF TEXTILES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of textiles in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

1. No person shall use any textile in any manufacturing business or factory not established at the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, for the purpose of manufacturing one or more of the classes of articles enumerated in the Schedule hereto, save with the prior consent of the Controller thereto in writing.

2. Any person who contravenes any provision of regulation 1 shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds and to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

3. In these regulations "Controller" means the Government Secretary or such other officer as the Resident Commissioner may appoint.

Bags; blankets; braces and suspenders; canvas goods; hats and caps; household linen; knitted garments; mattresses; millinery; men's and boys' outer garments; men's and boys' under garments; women's and maids' outer garments; women's and maids' under garments; shirts, collars and pyjamas; ties.
